Research

Outbreak of white grub adults on agroforestry tree species in pre-monsoon

Assessment of white grub adult outbreak on various promising agroforestry tree species like Butea monosperma Azadirachta indica, Parthenium hysterophorus mauritiana, Leucaena spp were studied at CAFRI farm. During the study extensive damage was observed on B. monosperma (94-95%) compared to other species. The adult beetles generally attacked the host plants during night hours (7 to 10). The damage symptoms included complete removal of host leaf tissue between veins and create holes at initial stage, and later eat away the whole tissue leaving only veins of the foliage. Further, the white grub species were collected from IGFRI campus. The samples were sent to ICAR-NBAIR, Bengaluru for identification. The results revealed that, a total of seven species



viz. Schizonycha fuscescens (Blanchard), Apogonia sp. Anomala bengalensis (Blanchard) Anomala dorsalis (Fabricius), Adoretus versutus Harold, and 2 Adoretus were identified on these five host plants. This pest can be managed by deep summer ploughing for destructing root grubs, removing the alternate hosts near the fields, setting of light traps for collection of adult beetles and subsequent destruction will be effective (1trap/ha between 7 to 10 pm) and spray Imidacloprid 17.8 SL @ 1.5ml/litre.
